National Portal for Rooftop Solar: Overview

The National Portal has been developed to facilitate the installation of residential grid connected rooftop solar plants. It was launched on 30th July 2022 by the Hon'ble Prime Minister Sh. Narendra Modi. Portal allows beneficiaries for registration followed by submitting application for installation. As of now, it encompasses three schemes: Phase I, Phase II and Simplified Procedure.

Objectives of the portal:

- ✓ Facilitate the ongoing scheme to achieve 40GW of RTS installation by 2026
- ✓ To act as a single source to register and apply for Residential Solar Rooftop Installation
- ✓ Ease the end-to-end process from application submission to CFA release(directly to beneficiary)
- ✓ Provide flexibility to consumer to select empanelled vendor of his choice
- ✓ Simplify the application edit request and rollback process to make necessary changes
- ✓ Provide flexibility to Discoms to transfer the application to respective circle, division and sub-division







Functionalities on the portal for Discoms

Current functionalities -

- Access to Dashboard
- Status update reports and data points
- Take actions on submitted applications (Feasibility check)
- Complete feasibility approval
- Inspection of approved applications
 - Assign to circle/division/sub-division
 - Complete on own
- Send alerts to respective Division/Nodal
- Add/edit/delete from existing vendor list
- Add/edit/delete from existing circles/divisions/subdivisions list

Upcoming functionalities –

- Automated month wise performance reports to respective Discoms
- Provision in the accounts of implementing agencies to view the status/pendency etc. in the respective circle/division
- Pending list of consumers for Bank details submission
- Option to download Dashboard KPIs in pdf format
- Provision to view Submission and Resubmission date at DISCOM account in Feasibility Check & Inspection Check
- Edit request module for MSR report
- Grievance redressal system at every stage of application

Discoms' Integration on the National Portal

The National Portal provides option to Discoms to integrate their respective portal. This enables them with the ease of application processing and seamless data exchange. As of now, 12 Discoms have integrated with the National Portal while <u>integration</u> of 15 Discoms is under process.

Benefits of Integration:

- Lesser turn around time for application processing
- ✓ Single registration for consumer
- ✓ Minimal chances of data duplicity
- Quick monitoring and tracking of applications
- ✓ Error free feasibility & inspection approval
- Easy identification and verification of consumers

Steps for Integration:

- 1. Raise request by writing to itsupport-mnre@nic.in
- 2. Technical documentation, testing token and key file to be shared by IT team
- 3. Post completion of testing, Discom to request for live token and key file for accessing real time data and their IP address for whitelisting
- If Discom wants the consumer to fill any additional document, then the same can be mentioned via Integration form on National Portal
